EU AGRICULTURE & FOOD SECURITY ARE AT RISK.

CONTEXT AND CHALLENGES

Demonstration takes place in the context of a deadlock in European agricultural policy, marked by:

- Unacceptable post-2027 CAP proposals that lack commonality and adequate funding
- Trade policy pursued by the EU at the clear disadvantage of the European agricultural sector
- The need for simplification, better regulations and legal certainty

Over 40 member organisations from 26 European countries have announced their presence at this march, where 10,000 farmers are expected! European farmers are demanding concrete solutions to guarantee their competitiveness, their income and the EU's food security.



ACCESS AND RECOMMENDATIONS
