If EU fails to act now, it risks losing one of its greatest strategic assets: the ability to feed itself & the world. Today, we see a paradox emerging in Europe: the European Commission speaks of agriculture and its strategic importance, yet its words are not followed by action!

We can no longer settle for rhetoric, we need results and tangible solutions for our farms and agricooperatives now. For us, things are very simple today: the three European institutions must respond to the following three demands; everything else will be considered mere smoke and mirrors!

STRONG, COMMON AND WELL-FUNDED CAP POST-2027

- Respect the CAP's twopillar structure and secure an inflation-proof budget
- Maintain the Commonality of the CAP to preserve the Single Market and vibrant rural areas across the EU
- Ensure the CAP drives food security, competitiveness, and fair income
- The same applies to Common Fisheries Policy!

FAIR AND TRANSPARENT TRADE

- Stop the Mercosur ratification
- No reciprocity, no effective safeguards, no deal
- Balanced imports from Ukraine not to destabilise EU producers
- Revise trade agreements as EU-US or EU-Marocco to include effective safeguards and reciprocity

REAL SIMPLIFICATION AND LEGAL CERTAINTY

- Postpone CBAM for fertilisers to avoid unaffordable costs
- An ambitious Environment
 Omnibus with targeted
 amendments (IED,
 Nitrates/Habitats/ Water
 Nature Restoration Law)
 aiming for better
 regulation, deblocking
 sustainable investments
- Accelerate approval of safe, effective plant protection products: No ban without alternatives!

Agriculture is one of the strongest symbols of European integration. If agriculture is struggling today, then it is the very viability of the European project that is at stake. European farmers and agricultures are committed Europeans, and we will do everything possible to prevent the European Union from making a strategic mistake that could prove extremely costly in the short, medium, and long term.
